





### **LEGAL ASPECTS**

The corresponding author should make it clear that the final manuscript has been approved by all authors and has not been published, or under the consideration by another journal. Copyright ownership is to be transferred by the following written statement which must accompany all manuscripts at the time of submission and must be signed by all authors: "The undersigned authors transfer all copyright ownership of the manuscript to Critical Care and Shock in the event the work is published. The undersigned authors warrant that the article is original, and is not under consideration by another journal and has not been published previously."

Manuscripts submitted for publications must contain a statement to the effect that all human studies have been approved by the appropriate ethics commitee and have therefore been performed in accordance with the ethical standards laid down in the 1964 Declaration of Helsinki. It should be also stated clearly in the text that all persons gave their informed consent prior to their inclusion in the study. Details that might disclose the identity of the subjects under study should be omitted.

Reports of animal experiments must state that the "Principles of laboratory animall care" were followed, as well as specific national laws where applicable.

The Editor-in-Chief reserves the right to reject manuscripts that do not comply with the above-mentioned requirements. The author will be held responsible for false statement or failure to fulfill these requirements.

### MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

It is highly recommended that authors submit manuscripts to Critical Care and Shock by email to **simonnanlohy@yahoo.com** whenever possible. Authors should submit a complete electronic file using .doc file type for text, and .jpg or .tiff for figures. Otherwise you may submit the manuscripts by mail in triplicate together with a diskette or a CD-ROM to the Managing Editor:

### Online Availability = Online Presence = Online Visibility?

Online visibility depends on how easy the Web site can be found by Search Engines and Ranked at the top of the search results



Factors influencing discoverability and ranking are:

- Less emphasis on key words, more on context, example at the point of searching,
  - where a person is,
  - what they are doing,
  - what time it is, etc.
- Links, not any links but quality of the links
- Long Form Quality versus Quantity of content and how fast they are posted on the site
- Mobile Optimization is the content loads clearly on mobile devices
- Google Scrapping allow Google to 'scrap' information from your site and so Google can research to a search query by displaying its own results

 Online Availability is about putting your best face (interface forward)

Improve Visibility is about findings your story – newsworthy story

- Editor's choice chosen to highlight from those published in the past 12 months
- Research highlights get authors to write 3-5 bullet points convey core findings and quick overview of their papers. Disseminate through mobile applications


- Mining relevant data from articles you published



## China Association for Science and Technology EJI Program

- Elite Science and Technology Journals Incubator(EJI) launched in 2006 to increase quality of Chinese Journals in three categories:
  - Type A internationally known series,
  - Type B domestic leading series and
  - Type C the elite potential series.
- By 2008, the project had granted funding to 317 items, including 147 journals with a total funds of RMB31.15 million yuan (Approximately USD\$ 5 million)
- Phase Two from 2009 to 2014: By 2014, the average cited frequency per journal increased by 25.4%.
- Phase Three Begins 2015, focus on:
  - Improved quality of manuscripts received,
  - Increase prestige of the editorial board,
  - Increase speed of publication
  - Provide author, reviewer and editor training,
  - Offer integrated digital dissemination of content.
